

Municipal general elections on November 7, 2021

IS YOUR DOMICILE LOCATED OUTSIDE THE MUNICIPALITY OR RCM?

You may have the right to vote if you are the **owner of a immovable** or if you have been the **occupant of a business establishment** in the municipality or in the RCM since September 1, 2020, or before.

You may be entitled to this right if, for instance, you are:

- Owner of an apartment building;
- Co-owner of a cottage or second home;
- Tenant of a commercial space.

To have this right, you must be 18 years of age or older on election day and be a Canadian citizen on September 1, 2021. You must not be under curatorship or deprived of your electoral rights on that date.

To exercise your voting right, you must submit an application for registration on the municipal list of electors, the RCM list of electors or the referendum list.

HOW TO APPLY

The form to be completed varies according to the applicant*:

- The **sole owner** of a immovable or the **sole occupant** of a business establishment must fill the attached SMR-9.2 form;
- The **co-owners** of a immovable or the **co-occupants** of a business establishment must designate one person among them to be registered on the list. To do so, they must fill the attached SMR-9.1 form.

The completed form must be sent to the address indicated below.

The application for registration on the list of electors or power of attorney remains valid until it is replaced or withdrawn. If you want to replace or withdraw an existing application or power of attorney, please contact the returning officer.

*For the application to be valid for the 2021 election, the municipality must receive it **by the set deadline for making an application to amend with the board of revisors**. The returning officer will specify the date in the coming months.
